<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hairdressing Level 2 and 3 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will need a tail comb, a model within your household with medium/long hair (short hair can be used if it can be clipped up) and nine sectioning clips 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will need some hair pins, bobbles, feathers, flowers and decorative pieces of your choice
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hair & Media Make-up Level 2 Make-up Specialist Level 2 Make-up Artistry Level 3 Theatrical Special Effects & Media Make-up Level 3 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will need sequins, gems, flowers and any adornments of your choice (for example, glitter), Vaseline and PVA glue You will need to skin test your model or yourself, if working on self, for the glue. Instructions to patch test - clean area behind the ear, apply glue, let it dry, leave for an hour, remove and inspect area for any irritation/itching or redness 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will need hairbrushes and combs, hairspray, bobbles, clips and decorative pieces
