

International scholarships and discounts

Terms and conditions

- 1. International scholarships and discounts are only available to students who are assessed by University College Birmingham (UCB) as having overseas international student status and who pay overseas international rate tuition fees.
- 2. The international scholarships are available to new international students starting on a full-time undergraduate or postgraduate course of study (foundation courses are not included). The values of the awards are determined from time to time, and will be advertised on the University's website. The scholarships are only available for courses that are taught on site at UCB's campus in Birmingham. Interested applicants should contact UCB if they have any further queries.
- 3. To be eligible, an applicant must fulfil the criteria outlined within each international scholarship. At a minimum, an applicant must:
 - (i) have received an offer to study on a full-time course, starting in the current academic year;(ii) have accepted their offer; and
 - (iii) have paid the tuition fee deposit to UCB.
- 4. Students can apply for an international scholarship once they have received a conditional offer from UCB. Please visit the scholarships and discounts page of the UCB website for updates regarding the availability of scholarships and discounts.
- 5. Awards will not be applied to students studying on part-time or distance learning courses, or in relation to courses with fees lower than the lowest standard international fee.
- 6. Decisions made by the UCB International Office regarding eligibility for all discounts and scholarships are final. Awards are made at the full and sole discretion of UCB. All awards will be limited in number due to funding.
- 7. UCB will use the University's website to advertise terms and conditions in relation to this award.
- 8. Applications for awards will only be accepted during specified time periods. These will be advertised within the scholarship pages on the UCB website. Any application received outside of this period will not be considered.
- 9. For the International Scholarship Award, no specific scholarship application is required. The scholarship will be automatically awarded to an applicant who meets the criteria outlined in Paragraph 3 (depending on availability). UCB strongly advises all applicants to check the international scholarships and discounts webpages carefully before making a deposit payment.
- 10. Successful scholarship recipients will be notified by email. Students awarded scholarships and discounts will have their awards applied automatically when they enrol.
- 11. All international scholarships will be given as tuition fee remissions and will only be awarded during the first year of study. Students will not be eligible to have the award applied in subsequent years of study, including repeated first year.



- 12. International scholarships are not transferable and cannot be deferred to an earlier or later start date.
- 13. A student can only be in receipt of one UCB scholarship. Students who meet the eligibility criteria for more than one of the scholarships will be awarded the scholarship which is the most financially beneficial to them. Only one scholarship per student per course will be applied.
- 14. Students are eligible to receive the Early Payment Discount in conjunction with other awards.
- 15. No cash alternatives will be offered.
- 16. Awards cannot be transferred to another recipient.
- 17. Only self-funded students are eligible for scholarships and discounts. Students in receipt of any type of sponsorship or third party funding will not be eligible.
- 18. UCB reserves the right to cancel any award which has been claimed fraudulently (including the provision of false information to claim the award), and to apply the full tuition fee. If an award is found to have been claimed fraudulently, the award amount will be added to the student's university account and must be paid in full before the end of the student's course.
- 19. Where a student who has been awarded an international scholarship terminates or interrupts their studies prior to the completion of their first year of study, the award will be pro-rata, based on the student's last date of attendance. This will be applied in accordance with the UCB fee and refund policy.
- 20. Recipients of a scholarship or discount must have no outstanding debt to the University at the point of the international scholarship being awarded.
- 21. By accepting the scholarship, students agree to accept the full terms, conditions and rules of the scholarship and agree to abide by the University rules and any requirements and/or proceedings issued by UCB in relation to the scholarship.
- 22. By applying for a scholarship or bursary, you agree to participate in marketing activities on UCB's website, social media channels and promotional materials such as email and print. Marketing activities may include but are not limited to video and photography. Materials may be distributed externally for promotional purposes.
- 23. By applying for a scholarship or bursary, you agree to the collection, retention, usage and distribution of your personal information in order to process and contact you about your application.
