



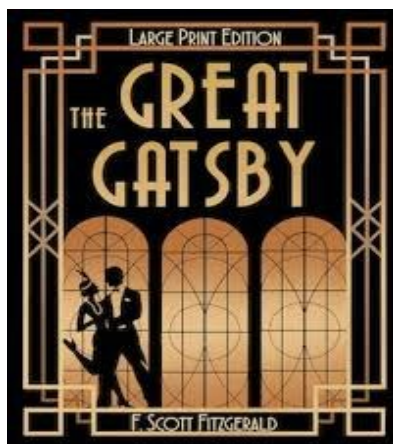

1/ Write a short summary of what happens in each chapter (no more than 50 words).



2/How does this text present love and relationships? Make some notes on what you learn about this theme in each of the chapters.

3/ Find out what you can about F. Scott Fitzgerald, the writer.
