POLICE REGISTRATION

How will I know if I have to register?

If your visa or visa letter says "police registration within 7 days of arrival" or "report extension to the Police" you must attend the office within 7 days to register.

What are the opening hours?

Monday - Thurs	09:00 - 12:30	13:30 - 15:30
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The Office is closed on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays.

What Documents do I needs for a first time registration?

- Biometric residence permits (if you have one)
- Valid passport with your entry visa vignette
- Completed registration form attached at the back
- UCB confirmation of student status letter
- Two recent passport size colour photographs
- £34 cash or card

Additional documents depending on your status and the police force you're registering with Please contact the police to find out. You may also have to fill in an application form before you register.

The police station will record:

- your full name
- your gender
- your marital status
- your date and country of birth
- your nationality
- your address in the UK
- the address of the last place you lived outside the UK
- the date and place you arrived in the UK, and how
- your passport details
- what you can and can't do with your visa, including how long you can stay
- if you're a student or working

Once you have registered, you will need to report any of these changes to the Police (NO LATER THAN 7 DAYS)

- Change of residential address
- Change of work address or occupation
- Visa extension
- New passport
- Change of name, nationality, passport/travel document or marital status

To report any of these changes, you must go to the office with your passport, Police Registration Certificate and proof of address (bill, bank statement, letter from UCB).


I have already registered with the Police in another city; do I need to register again?

If you have registered with the Police in another city but now live in the West Midlands you are required to report to the Police. You will need to attend the office with the following:

- Valid passport and visa
- Police Registration Certificate
- 1 passport sized photograph
- This registration form

You will not need to pay again if you have previously registered with the Police.
