



## Nursing (Adult) BSc and Kick-Start

### Uniform Requirements

For the practical sessions you will be undertaking, you will be required to wear appropriate uniform. The good news is that there is help towards the cost of purchasing the uniform through **The Kick-Start Scheme**.



The Kick-Start Scheme provides all new, Home (generally speaking this means UK) and EU students, studying a full-time undergraduate course with £300 funds at the start of the year. UK students with a household income of below £25,000 will be entitled to a further £500 at the start of semester 2 (i.e. February). These funds, which do not need to be paid back, can be used at [www.ucb-kickstart.co.uk](http://www.ucb-kickstart.co.uk) (to order your uniform and equipment) and also on selected on-campus purchases. Kick-Start funds will be awarded automatically to all eligible students – you do not need to apply for this separately. Once your enrolment has been completed you will receive a message to your UCB email account confirming that your funds have been released.

### Enrolment

Enrolment will be open from **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September**. It is important that you order your uniform soon after you enrol. This will ensure that that you receive what you need in time for the practical sessions.

### Tablet

If you are studying **Year 1** of Nursing (Adult) BSc, UCB will be providing you with a tablet to use to support you with your studies inside and outside of the classroom. This is your own personal device. You will be provided with further information on how you can receive this soon after you have enrolled.
